## ENG 112: Writing and Research in the Disciplines: Globalized Activities

<u>Course Description:</u> This course, the second in a series of two, introduces research techniques, documentation styles, and writing strategies. Emphasis is placed on analyzing information and ideas and incorporating research findings into documented writing and research projects. Upon completion, students should be able to evaluate and synthesize information from primary and secondary sources using documentation appropriate to various disciplines.

<u>Description of Module:</u> The purpose of this module is to give English instructors ready-made assignments for their globalized ENG 112 class. This module gives activities and resources for both small and large assignments that integrate international issues into the ENG 112 curriculum. Instructors should feel free to use the resource provided, to ask students to do their own individual research or consider other international topics that relate.
