

Activity #4: Human Rights, Taking Action

Task: Students will create in Spanish a one minute Public Service Announcement (PSA) or Poster that features an issue relating to one of the 30 Human Rights Articles. The announcement must contain the following. A documented issue or situation that is evidence that not everyone is protected by 30 Articles of Human Rights developed by the United Nations.

Current, or recent issues can be found by putting the phrase “violations of human rights/ violaciones a los derechos humanos” into a search engine.

Checklist:

_____ The poster or or PSA will state the fact-based issue that violates one of the articles of the human rights.

_____ The poster or PSA will state why/how it violates it violates the article, also making it clear which article is violated.

_____ The student will propose at least one solution or action to make the situation better.

_____ The student will get feedback (corrections and suggestions) and permission from the teacher before disseminating the PSA or poster.

_____ The student will provide evidence that the poster or PSA has been shared in some way with a Spanish-speaking community. This sharing can be as local as on the campus of their own school if there is a large population of Spanish speakers. The sharing can be as international as posted on some form of social media.

_____ The student will make some effort to gather feedback from the community regarding the PSA or poster.

_____ The student will share out the final product and the feedback with the class.
