4. What role did music play in your early childhood? Teenage years? Adulthood?
5. How would you compare your teenage years to teenagers today? How are things different? The same?
6. What activities were you involved in as a child? What role did music play in these events?
7. Describe your first live music experience.
8. How was your musical experience as a teenager different from now?
