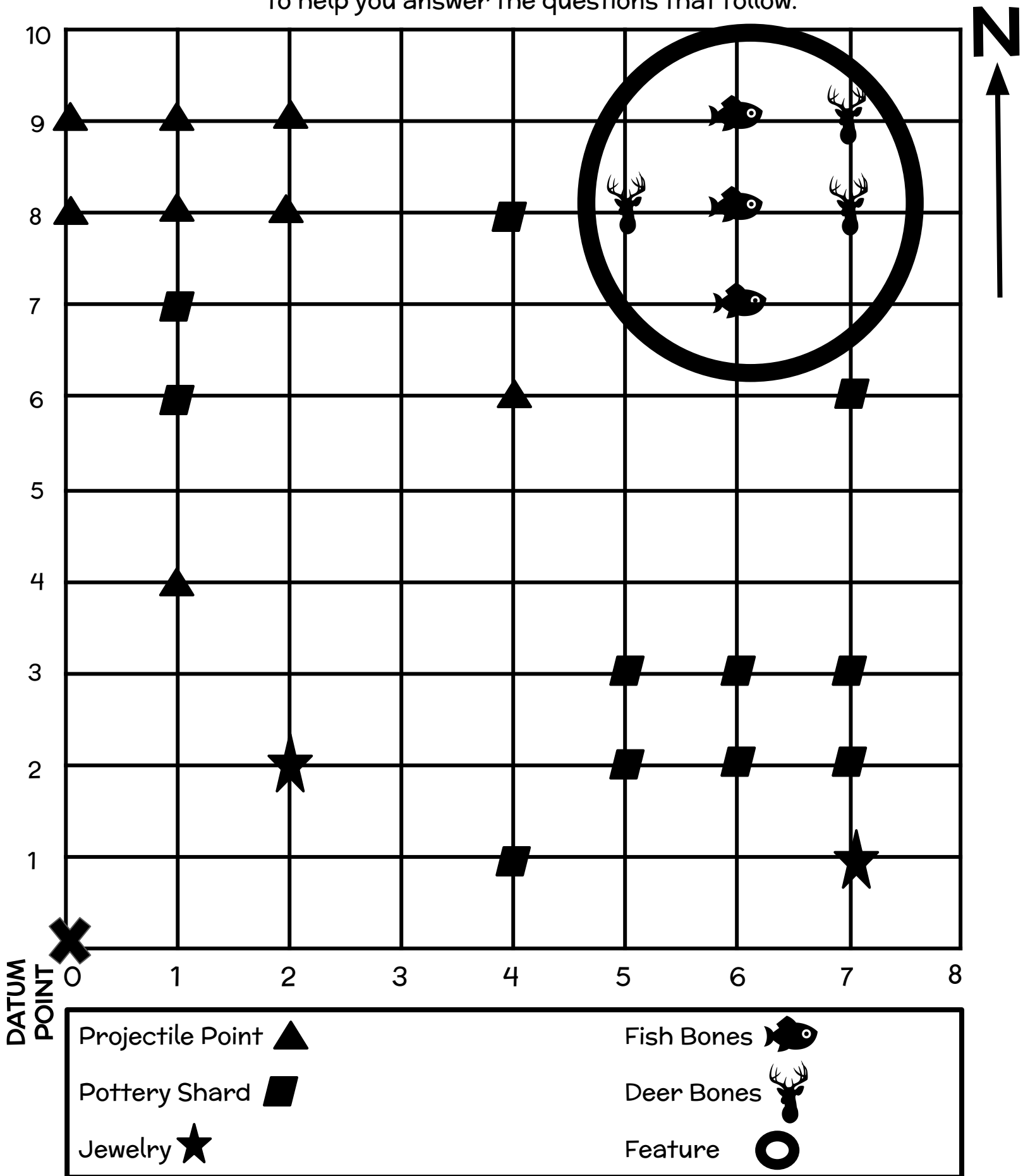

Several artifacts have been plotted on the site grid below. Use the map key to help you answer the questions that follow.



List the locations (ordered pairs) for each of the following items

Based on the items recovered from the site, what did the people that once lived here like to eat?

Artifacts are things made and used by people. What sorts of tools did these people use?

Archaeologists tend to take special notice of many artifacts that are recovered in close proximity to one another. These typically indicate “activity areas.” There can be activity areas for things like cooking, stone toolmaking, etc. What activity areas do you notice on this site?

A “feature” has been marked in the top right corner of the site grid. Given what was recovered within this feature, can you make a prediction of what that area was used for?
