## Choose a Country. Create a Plan.

Hello Students! In an effort to solve global issues, the United Nations created 17 goals for the nations of the world to reach by year 2030. The goals include subjects ranging from literacy to responsible use of resources to human rights! These goals are known as the Sustainable Development Goals or SDGs. <u>To learn more about the Sustainable Development goals, click this link.</u>

For this project, you will work in groups to create an action plan to solve one of the SDGs in a country of your group's choice. Your group will present this action plan to the class.

### **Group Work Guidelines:**

- Each group must choose a <u>unique</u> combination of country and SDG; no group may do the exact same country and SDG combination.
- Every group member must contribute to the project equally.
- If there is conflict within the group that the group cannot resolve, please speak with your teacher for mediation.

### **Action Plan Requirements:**

- At least 1 paragraph providing background information on your chosen country and the issues it faces relating to your chosen SDG
- At least 3 national level strategies that focus on achieving the SDG by 2030.
  - O Strategies should include the estimated cost of the strategy, resources needed to achieve it, the groups responsible for achieving it, and a timeline for putting the strategy into place.
- I highly recommend you use the template I have provided. However, if your group would like to create their own, they may do so.
- All parts of the project must be neat, use correct spelling and grammar, and reflect the topic.
- All resources used for the project must be included on the Works Cited Page and written in correct APA format. This should be included in your Action Plan and in your presentation.

#### **Presentation Requirements:**

- Presentations must be at least 5 minutes in length.
- All group members must speak during the presentation.
- Your group must create a tri-fold or keynote presentation as part of your presentation. Both can be used if your group wishes to do so.
  - O Make sure your presentation is neat, eye-catching, and uses correct grammar and spelling.
- Be sure to include your Works Cited page as part of your presentation.
