Gallery Walk Participation	Student actively read and evaluated the one-pagers designed by others.	Student read and evaluated the one-pagers designed by others. The student needed to be reminded to focus at least once.	Student needed to be reminded several times to focus and participate in the activity. The student distracted other people from their participation in the activity.
